City of Tumwater's Community Matching Fund

The Community Matching Fund was established as part of the Tumwater City Council's strategic priority to...

Build a community recognized for quality.

The Community Matching Fund makes grants available to community groups through two programs:

- Neighborhood Event Grants; and
- Neighborhood Project Grants.

The Neighborhood Match

Grants up to \$250 are made available to groups that organize to host an event to benefit the neighborhood. **Groups must match the grant funding with a minimum of 50 percent of total event costs with volunteer hours, in-kind donations, and/or cash resources.**

Grant funding is limited. Apply today!

Note: Groups may be required to secure insurance to host events which may be included as a match.

Is your group eligible to apply?

Any neighborhood or community group (formal or informal) with the majority of its members living and/or working in the City of Tumwater is eligible to apply. Organizations, business groups, and neighborhood-based groups are examples of eligible applicants. Individual applicants, religious organizations, or political groups are not eligible to receive awards. Groups are eligible to receive a Neighborhood Event Grant once every three years.

What events are eligible for funds?

To be considered for funding, an event must be non-profit in nature, take place within the City of Tumwater and must have a direct benefit to the neighborhood or community. *Funds must be used by December 31 of the year in which the grant was awarded.*



Examples of events

- Neighborhood block parties or picnics
- National Night Out Activities
- Neighborhood clean-ups
- Movie nights

How are applications evaluated?

Grant funds are available for the calendar year on a first-come, first-served basis. Applicants must demonstrate the following:

- Project Readiness;
- Community Engagement; and
- Community Benefit.

When are applications accepted?

Applications are accepted year-round and can be found on the City of Tumwater's website at www.ci.tumwater.wa.us/neighborhoodgrants and at Tumwater City Hall (555 Israel Road SW).
