We will complete the final stages of the new Deschutes Valley neighborhood park on "T" Street in late January. The City has contracted with KBH Construction to install the final park amenities including a new play structure, restroom and other park improvements. This new park was originally planned in 1997 and through a partnership with the LOTT Cleanwater Alliance, we have developed a facility that includes both a one million gallon reclaimed water storage tank for irrigation use at the park and the Tumwater Valley Golf Course as well as a new neighborhood park with fantastic views of the Deschutes River Valley. 
### Community Involvement

The purpose of Tumwater Parks and Recreation’s Counselor-In-Training (CIT) program is to provide, through practical experience and hands-on learning, the skills that are essential to become an effective camp counselor. Teens who wish to be considered for the CIT Program must complete an application and meet with the Recreation Coordinator. At Tumwater Day Camp, CITs will assist counselors as well as other staff members in providing a caring atmosphere and exciting experience for the day camp participants. 


